Most Spiritual Growth From: Attending church.

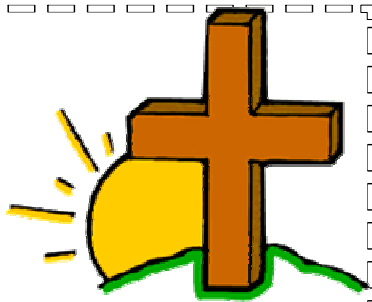
